- ⇒ There are limitations, by law, there can only be 2 heartbeats in a studio or 1 bedroom, and only 4 in a 2 bedroom apartment.
 - ⇒ Anyone over the age of 18 needs to complete a rental application PRIOR to moving in.
 - ⇒ Roommates will not be added to your lease, however we do require a criminal background history be run on every resident, as well as emergency contact information.
 - ⇒ If the occupant is under 18 years of age, please provide the office with their full name, date of birth, and relationship to yourself.
 - ⇒ There will be a \$20 application fee for all roommates.
 - ⇒ If there is an unauthorized occupant in your apartment, we may ask them to move until such time as we can process an application for them.

COMMUNITY TIPS

- ⇒ **SPEED LIMIT 10 MPH** Please keep the posted speed limit in mind when traveling in our parking lot. This is for your safety, as well as others. Many residents walk their garbage to the dumpsters, walk their pets on a frequent basis, and there are young children at play as well. We are concerned for the safety of everyone. *Thank you!*
- ⇒ **KEEP DUMPSTERS CLOSED** Raccoons are not our friends, and leaving dumpster lids open is a great invitation for pests, we ask that you be mindful to close the lid once you’ve deposited your garbage. *We appreciate you!*
- ⇒ **KEEP LAUNDRY ROOM CLOSED** Please keep the laundry room doors closed, the laundry rooms are not heated and leaving the doors open in winter can cause pipes to burst and flood. *Your neighbors will thank you!*

HOW TO PREVENT PESTS

Spring is quick approaching and the bugs will be out, here are some helpful hints to prevent pests from venturing into your home.

- ⇒ Check your window screens for holes or tears, if you notice anything please call the office so we can get those sealed or repaired for you right away!
- ⇒ Store garbage in sealed containers and dispose of it regularly.
- ⇒ Don’t leave food out on countertops or open inside cabinets.
- ⇒ If you don’t have time to wash a dish, at least rinse food residue off to keep from attracting pests.
- ⇒ Keep your cabinets clean from crumbs and food debris that may attract pests.
- ⇒ If you notice any unwanted visitors please contact the office immediately to schedule a pest control visit.
